What you will learn

This training covers the skills and knowledge to operate a skid steer loader and to carry out associated work. It includes:

- Planning and preparing for skid steer loader operations
- Operating the skid steer loader
- Loading, carrying and placing materials
- Selecting, removing and fitting attachments
- Relocating the skid steer loader
- Carrying out machine operator maintenance
- Conducting housekeeping activities associated with machine operations.

Entry requirements

- Basic level of language, literacy and numeracy (will be assessed during enrolment process).
- Ability to speak and understand English – training and assessment will be conducted in English
- You do not need any experience, skills or knowledge in operating a skid steer loader or any other plant equipment or machinery.

How long the training will take

You will complete approximately:

- 3 days face to face plus 30 hours on-the-job logbook practice – if you are undertaking the training in Australia.
- 4 days face to face plus 30 hours on-the-job logbook practice – if you are undertaking the training overseas (outside of Australia).

However, the time over which you complete the training will largely depend on how long it takes you to complete the required 30 hours of on-the-job practice and when the assessor is available to conduct the follow-up practical assessment. The estimates given assume three (3) hours of logbook practice per day for five (5) days per week for two (2) weeks.

How and where you will be trained

- Face to face training in your workplace - theory content and practice operating the machine
- On-the-job logbook practice - tasks relevant to this training that you carry out in your workplace over a period of time, after you have successfully completed the theory assessment
- You are also required to spend approximately 1 hour of your own time revising learning material you will be given.

How you will be assessed

- Written theory assessment.
- Practical demonstration of skills.



What you need to bring

- Photo identification
- Pen/biro
- Personal protective equipment (PPE):
 - Steel capped boots
 - Safety clothing (hi-visibility long pants and long sleeve shirt)
 - Hard hat
 - Safety glasses
 - Gloves
 - Hearing protection

If your employer's site policies require you to have additional or different PPE to that listed above, you must bring those items to training.

You must bring the above items to training each day. If you come to training without the right PPE, you may not be allowed to participate in training.

Cost of training

- You may have to purchase PPE (identified above) if not available for use in your workplace.

What you get at the end of training

- Upon successful completion, you will receive a Statement of Attainment (*RIIMPO318F Conduct civil construction skid steer loader operations*).
